

APL Wireless Internet Access for Instructors

Two items are needed prior to connecting:

- SSID and WPA2-PSK Key for access point
- UNIX Account username and password

Wireless Access Point

SSID JHU-EP
WPA2-PSK Key TextBook (case sensitive)

UNIX Accounts for instructors can be obtained by submitting an online request:

1. Go to the website <http://apl.jhu.edu>
2. Scroll to the bottom of the page.
3. On the left side of the page, click the link titled “Instructor & Staff UNIX Account Form”
4. Fill out the application and click the “Submit Request” button.
5. You will be contacted with your account information in a few days.

*Note that this request process is only for instructors. Students can stop by the APL Education Center (L-1) or the UNIX Computer Lab (K-221) for instructions on obtaining a UNIX account.

Wireless login procedure:

1. Connect to the JHU-EP wireless access point.
2. If a password is requested, enter the provided WPA2-PSK key.
 - a. If you have previously logged on the JHU-EP wireless access point, your computer may have saved the WPA2-PSK key and you may not need to enter it again.
3. Once that connection is made, open up a web browser.
4. Upon trying to access any web page, you will be redirected to a login page.
5. Enter your UNIX account information.
6. You should receive a confirmation message.
7. You are now logged on to the wireless!
