What you need to do:

- Identify a project. The mentor for each project is identified on the capstone homepage.
- Identify a group of fellow students for your team (Three to five students per team)<sup>1</sup>.
- Each member of the team must submit an individual form.
- Talk to your adviser to verify you qualify for a capstone.
  - You have completed seven courses that apply to your degree.
  - You have satisfied the foundation course requirement.
  - You have satisfied the track requirement.
  - You have completed at least one 700 level course. The capstone will apply as a 700 level course.
  - You have strong grades.
- Fill out this form.
  - You must list your team members.
  - You must list both the title and the section number of the project of interest.
  - You must list the mentor.
- Send the form to your adviser for approval.
- Your adviser will send it to the Chair for approval.
- The Chair will send the approved form to the registration staff.
- The staff will register you.

<sup>1</sup> If you cannot identify -at least two other team members, you can still submit the form and we will try to assign you to a team, but there are no guarantees. It would be a good idea to write in a second choice project on the form.
